Philip	crucified
Thomas	speared to death




- Addendum: Tombs of famous people are often times revered by their followers.

Outrageous Claims of Other Eyewitnesses



The Stages of Life

1. Present Life: Body and Soul living in sinful world.

2. **Heavenly Life**: Soul seperated from body at death. With the Lord in heaven.

3. Resurrected Life: Soul is reuinited with resurrected body at the Second Coming. New Heavens and New Earth.

Immediately After Death

- Luke 23:42-43: "Then he said to him, 'Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.' Jesus answered him, 'I tell you the truth, today you will be with me."
- Acts 7:59: "While they were stoning him, Stephen prayed, "Lord Jesus recieve my spirit.""
- Philippians 1:23: "I desire to depart and be with Christ which is better by far; but it is necessary for you that I remain in the body."

Immediately After Death

- Revelation 14:13: "Then I heard a voice from heaven say,
 'Write: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on."
- Psalm 16:11: "You will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand."






