#### Types of theology

- Biblical theology
- Systematic theology
- Practical theology
- Historical theology

Systematics/Systematic theology: a form of theology in which the aim is to arrange religious truths in a self-consistent whole; (topical/doctrinal)

### Knowledge of God:

Natural & Revealed

Limited; the extent of revealed knowledge includes all that is necessary

#### Takeaway:

The Limits of our knowledge of God:

through natural knowledge (nature, conscience, universal belief, reason)

there is a God

Extent AND Limit: Through the revelation of God in Trinity through the Son, and

through Scripture: all that is necessary for salvation



 Nobody seems to know when the diagram originated, though it is at least as old as the twelfth century and is a straightforward representation of the first part of the Athanasian Creed.

The Trinity in:

Creation:

Genesis 1:26

God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness."

#### John 1:1-4

In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men.

## Jesus' baptism:

Matthew 3:16-17

When Jesus was baptized, immediately we went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him; and behold, a voice from heaven said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

The Great Commission:

Matthew 28:19-20

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."



Unity in the Trinity is best understood as "Tri-unity" Mark 12:29-31

The most important command is "Hear O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one." And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength."

#### One God, Three Persons



3 distinct persons

1 what & 3 whos

God, in himself, has both unity and diversity.

God eternally exists in three persons: Father, Son, Spirit

Equal; relate to the world (economically) and each other (ontologically) differently

How does this inform the life of humanity created in God's image?

Why this matters;

We are created in God's image for relationship, for community, for love.

Loneliness is not sinful.

"Alone" is "not good."
