#### **THESIS**

Tim Keller: The main problem, then, in the Christian life is that we have not thought out the deep implications of the gospel, we have not "used" the gospel in and on all parts of our life... All of us, to some degree live around the truth of the gospel but do not "get" it. So the key to continual and deeper spiritual renewal and revival is the continual re-discovery of the gospel.<sup>1</sup>

### **GOD'S TELOS – TO COME**

Telos – the end to which all things relate, the aim, the ultimate purpose that is to come

You've got a telos...

#### God has a telos

**1 CORINTHIANS 15:24–26** - Then comes the end (*telos*), when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power. For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death.

### THE ABUNDANCE OF OUR LABOR

Abounding is a Greek word (peri-seu-eh-o) – present active participate. (a present, ongoing action)

#### **EPHESIANS 1:18-20**

I pray that you may know... what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might that he worked in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places.

**2 CORINTHIANS 12:9-10** - But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

**HEBREWS 4:9-11** - So then, there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God, for whoever has entered God's rest has also rested from his works as God did from his. Let us therefore strive to enter that rest. Now we who have believed enter that rest, just as God has (declared).

1. UP STREAM: GOD'S WORK FOR YOU

**Martin Luther** - "The mother who sweeps her kitchen is doing the will of God just as much as the monk who prays—not because she may sing a Christian hymn as she sweeps but because God loves clean floors. The Christian shoemaker does his Christian duty not by putting little crosses on the shoes, but by making good shoes, because God is interested in good craftsmanship."

**1 CORINTHIANS 15:58** - Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that **IN THE LORD** your labor is not in vain.
