

## Honest Questions Deserve Honest Answers

Jimmy was 5 years old. One night he came to the dinner table with dirty hands. His mother said to him, "Get up right now! You know better than to come to the table like that! There are germs all over your hands. Hurry up and wash, we're about to pray." And so, Jimmy got up from the table and he headed for the bathroom mumbling to himself: "Germs and Jesus. Germs and Jesus. That's all I ever hear about in this house and I've never seen either one!"



Maybe there have been times when you have felt a little like Jimmy. You've never seen Jesus and so perhaps you have wondered if the story of Easter is actually true. As someone who has had his own faith struggles, I take comfort knowing the resurrection was as inconceivable for the first disciples as it is for many of us today. The women who came to the tomb the first Easter morning were bringing spices to anoint a dead body. Though Jesus had repeatedly told them He was going to rise from the dead, no one was actually expecting it to happen. And even though Jesus gave His disciples "many convincing proofs that He was alive" (Acts 1:3), some of them still doubted. It's important for us to remember the people of Jesus' day were not predisposed to believe in resurrection any more than we are.

After the resurrection of Christ, when the earliest followers of Jesus were finally convinced it was actually God who had died for them, and God who had conquered death and the grave, they were swept away by a love and a joy that was unstoppable. Their hearts were filled by something so much greater than themselves, and thus, they went from being a frightened group hiding in the darkness to risking everything professing what they knew to be true: "Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!"

At Our Father, we are a supportive and loving community where you can bring your doubts, questions, and struggles. We believe honest questions deserve honest answers. Moreover, we believe that the resurrection of Christ is not just something to believe in; it's something to be lived. The tomb was empty. And that changes everything.
