## Love Your Neighbor: Joining Jesus on His Mission

Jesus once condensed all the commandments down to just two. He said we are to love God with everything we have and to love our neighbors as ourselves. For most of us, this simple idea of loving our neighbors has been reduced to merely a nice saying - remaining more of an abstract concept than a way of life. But what would happen if every follower of Jesus took the Great Commandment literally? What would happen if every member of Our Father was more intentional in reaching out to those God has placed in our lives?

After months of mission discussion, preparation and exploration, it is time to start! Come together with other **members of Our Father as we are trained to "Join Jesus on His Mission" right here in Centennial, Colorado!** Rev. Greg Finke, author of the book, "Joining Jesus on His Mission," will be here on Saturday, November 3 from 9:00am to 2:00pm to lead a special workshop on how to become everyday missionaries in the places we already live, work and go to school. **By God's grace, we will leave the training with three things:** 1) a sense of relief and excitement about what it means to be an everyday missionary with Jesus; 2) a simple plan for personally joining Jesus in everyday life; and 3) a plan for regularly receiving the encouragement, insight and accountability we need for sustaining this journey.

To get us ready for the workshop, we will begin a special four-week "Joining Jesus" sermon series on October 13-14. **This series will focus on insights from Rev. Finke's book and will emphasize this important truth: We don't simply live our lives for Jesus, but rather with Him.** Wherever we go, Jesus is also there. And Jesus is always up to something for His kingdom. We will learn how to be on mission and recognize where Jesus is already at work in our neighborhoods, workplaces and schools.

*Rev. Greg and Susan Finke are the founders of Dwelling 1:14, a non-profit ministry which trains people to do two things: 1) how to join Jesus on His mission as part of their everyday lives, and 2) how to disciple their family and friends to do the same. *Before founding Dwelling 1:14 in 2011, Greg had been the senior pastor of Messiah Lutheran in Midland, Michigan for 18 years and Gloria Dei Lutheran in Houston, Texas for three years. His new book, "Joining Jesus on His Mission" has been widely recognized as a simple but powerful resource for helping ordinary people join Jesus as everyday missionaries in their communities.*

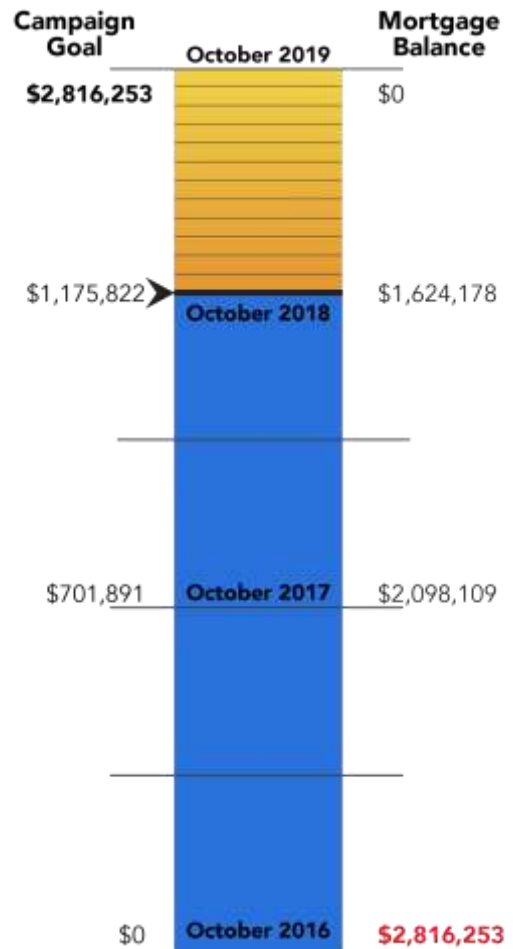
**Arise! Update...The Final Push**

October 2018 marks the beginning of our final year of the Arise! Campaign. By the grace of God, significant strides have been accomplished in the first two years of the campaign. To date, total contributions to Arise! have exceeded total pledged offerings. This means we have had numerous contributions not pledged when the campaign began. Official campaign kick-off in October 2016 began with our mortgage balance at \$2,816,253. As of October 1, 2018 our mortgage has been reduced to \$1,624,178, a 42% reduction!

Throughout the remaining year of our campaign, expect to see frequent updates on the financial progress, ways to further engage in the campaign, learn of other missional opportunities as a result of accomplishing the campaign's goals, all leading toward a final celebration of God's blessing to Our Father. By eliminating our mortgage, we attain fiscal stability thereby moving us closer to attaining
