Everyone goes through tough situations - there is no need to make this journey alone.


Consider allowing a Need-Based Caregiver (NBC) to come alongside as you work through a crisis or difficult time.

Someone who could use comfort or support because they are:

- Experiencing a time of transition or loss
- Grieving the loss of a loved one
- Lonely or discouraged
- In a spiritual crisis
- Unemployed or in a job crisis
- Having marital difficulties
- Dealing with issues related to aging
- Providing care to someone else
- Dealing with a chronic health issue
- Facing challenges with children or parents
- Struggling financially

What is a Need-Based Care Minister?

- A compassionate person who is here to focus on your needs.
- A trustworthy listener who will hold your concerns in confidence.
- A follower of Jesus who trusts Him to provide distinctively Christian care through us.
- A member of Our Father who has completed 30 hours of training in real life issues.
- Someone who will support, encourage, pray for your situation.

Our Need-Based Caregivers are ready to meet with you on a weekly basis to listen and offer words of encouragement and loving challenge. This care is offered at no charge.
